

## Index to the 1860 Industrial Census for Summit County, Ohio

Indexed by Jane Gramlich

This index lists names of individuals and companies involved in manufacturing for towns and townships in Summit County in 1860. The Federal Industrial Census provides data that supplements other genealogical records and provides some insight about an ancestor's livelihood. Enumerators gathered this census data within days of the collection of population schedule census information. Not all industries were counted. In 1860, only industries whose annual production was worth at least five hundred dollars were counted.

In addition to the name of the manufacturer and the type of products manufactured, the 1860 Industrial Census recorded the amount of capital invested in the business; the quantities, kinds, and values of raw material and fuel used; the kind of power used; average number of hands employed, both male and female, and the average monthly cost of their labor; and the quantities, kinds, and values of the annual product.

Names of individuals/companies are arranged alphabetically. Both these names and names of business, manufacture, or product are transcribed as they appear to the indexer, even with obvious misspellings. Misreading of the handwriting of census takers may have resulted in the misspelling of some names by the indexer. Census pages are numbered, but are out of order on microfilm. More than one location may be included on one page. Locations are the towns of Akron, Cuyahoga Falls and Middlebury; and the townships of Bath, Boston, Copley, Coventry, Franklin, Hudson, Green, Northampton, Northfield, Norton, Portage, Richfield, Springfield, Tallmadge, and Twinsburg. There are no entries for Stow Township. Line numbers refer to the nearest printed line number where the name appears. Words or letters given in brackets are estimates due to illegibility.

Partnerships or companies with two or more surnames are indexed under each surname. For example, Webster, Taplin & Co. appears twice, under W (as Webster, Taplin & Co.), and under T (as Taplin: Webster, Taplin & Co.). Census takers often crossed out certain terms under the name of the industry and replaced them with others; where legible, all terms have been included. Interpretation of abbreviations is left to the researcher.
